WORKSHOPS

AIAI hosts complimentary workshops to address a particular state or agency's needs. Agendas and presentation materials are developed to incorporate market and sector specific requirements.

Led by public sector peers, **P3DIRECT** creates opportunities for dialogue to address specific questions and topical issues of interest.

VIDEO & WEB EDUCATION

Utilizing the latest in online communications technology, our industry experts and public sector representatives can bring P3 education and experience directly to your conference room.

P3DIRECT PORTAL

AIAI's P3DIRECT online portal is designed for public sector representatives, with the goal of connecting peers to collaborate and discuss best practices.

The program allows us to deliver P3 education, provide information, share resources, offer access to experienced P3 practitioners and address any misconceptions that taxpayers may have regarding P3s.

Run by public sector P3 experts, P3DIRECT is a program implemented by AIAI for the public sector as a means to create a connection between experienced P3 professionals and those looking to gain more information on the P3 procurement model across agencies at every level.

WEBINARS

AIAI produces an introductory series of webinars delivered to public officials who desire a fundamental understanding of the model. The series covers:

- P3 The Basics: Understanding the Model and the **Benefits**
- P3 Case Studies: **Practical Examples of P3 Projects**
- P3 Lessons Learned: **Best Practices and Pitfalls to Avoid**

After this introduction, participants are encouraged to take a deeper dive into topics such as: Repayment Mechanisms, Risk, and Financing Structures.



Committees

AIAI's committees provide a valuable opportunity for member participation.

In addition to the ten commmittees, AIAI hosts a number of working groups in areas including airports, finance and the P3 Coalition.

COMMUNITY BASED INFRASTRUCTURE


GOVERNMENT AFFAIRS

At the Federal level, this committee is focused on building dialogue with pro-P3 stakeholders, and advocating legislative and administrative proposals in support of P3s. The committee addresses issues common to P3s and engages at the state level.



LAW & LEGISLATIVE

This committee focuses on shoring up seemingly stable P3 markets and introducing new possibilities to emerging markets, recommending best practices for legislative frameworks, responding to calls to action to establish viable P3 programs and monitoring changes in the legislative landscape.



OPERATIONS & MAINTENANCE

The O&M Committee looks to anticipate changes that could positively affect the P3 marketplace, respond to potential threats towards P3 growth and expansion, and support advocacy outreach for the P3 model.
