No; however, §19.75.011, establishes the Knik Arm Bridge and Toll Authority. Under the Alaska Administrative Code, 17 AAC 95.040, the authority is authorized to enter into P3s in any form to finance, design, construct, maintain, improve or operate the Knik Arm Bridge.
