8. What is the legislative foundation for P3s in this state?

The Rhode Island Legislature <u>considered a bill (S0803)</u> during the 2023 session to create the Public Private Partnership Infrastructure Program. The bill was referred to a study committee. The Legislature also <u>considered S6001</u>, a bill to authorize Rhode Island Public Transit Authority to procure projects including the Dorrance Street transit center using design build contracting and progressive design build contracting, but his matter was held for further study.
