Tennessee established a Transportation Modernization Board in April 2023 as part of its expanded P3 and alternative project delivery statutes. Processes and procedures are still being developed.

4. Does this state have a Centralized Agency dedicated to P3?

Tennessee Department of Transportation (TDOT).

5. Is this a Home Rule state, with limitations or opportunities for P3?

Yes.

6. What Projects or Asset Classes are eligible for P3 in this state?

Transportation projects, including, but not limited to, design, right-of-way acquisition, construction, and utility relocation.
