

Bayonne Municipal Utilities Authority, Bayonne, New Jersey

Objective:

- Provide safe drinking water to its residents
- Comply with drinking water standards
- Reduce debt due to maintenance of aqueducts

Solution:

- The joint venture made an initial payment of \$150 million to the city
- Eliminated the \$130 million debt the city had
- Estimated to save the city around \$35 million over the 40-year contract

Issues Solved:

 Relieved the financial stress of maintaining the aqueducts, while also relieving the city of its debt which would have led to bad credit

Partnerships:

 KKR and United Water (Suez) pledged to pay an additional \$157 million for the length of the contract, with \$2.5 million of that specifically going towards maintenance
