What is IACET?

The International Accreditors for Continuing Education and Training (IACET) establishes a recognized standard for continuing education and training. It independently reviews providers against the ANSI/IACET Standard.

What is an IACET CEU?

A Continuing Education Unit is a consistent measure of non-credit professional learning. One IACET CEU equals 10 contact hours in an eligible, organized learning experience. CEUs are awarded only when the offering and learner meet AIAI's stated requirements.

How portable is that value?

[IACET's Acceptance Directory](#) contains 372 employers, professional associations, universities, government agencies, and licensing or regulatory bodies reported to recognize, accept, recommend, or require IACET CEUs. The list includes the U.S. EPA, AIA, SHRM, NSPE, Texas DOT, numerous state engineering boards, environmental and water-sector authorities, and safety-certification bodies.

What does AIAI's status mean for me?

It means AIAI's systems for designing, delivering, assessing, documenting, and improving learning have undergone external review. You are not simply attending a course; you are participating in structured professional learning built around defined outcomes.

How can CEUs help me in my current role?

They create a documented record of relevant development you can use in performance reviews, development plans, credential files, and conversations about expanded responsibility. Just as important, AIAI learning helps you bring stronger P3 judgment and a shared vocabulary back to your team.
