COMMUNITY BASED INFRASTRUCTURE

Raising awareness of the value and benefits of P3 for municipal facilities and other vertical infrastructure assets, the predominant activities align with and are produced in conjunction with the Education Committee.

ENERGY INFRASTRUCTURE

GOVERNMENT AFFAIRS
